### **HOW TO USE**

Charge the Powerbank: Before using the powerbank for the first time, charge it using the provided cable (typically USB-C to USB-A or USB-C to USB-C). Plug one end into a wall adapter or power source, and the other end into the powerbank. The powerbank will show the charging status

## through LED indicators.

Charging Your Device via MagSafe (For iPhones with MagSafe): For MagSafe-compatible iPhones, simply place your phone directly on the MagSafe charging pad of the powerbank. The magnets will automatically align and securely attach the phone to the powerbank.

Charging Other Devices (Wired Charging): If your device does not support MagSafe, you can still charge it using the powerbank's USB-A or USB-C output ports (depending on your device's

compatibility). Plug the appropriate cable into one of the output ports and connect the

other end to your device. Your device will begin charging.

Checking the Battery Level: Press the power button on the powerbank to check its remaining charge. The LED indicators will show how much power is left in the powerbank.

Turning Off the Powerbank: When you're done using the powerbank, press the power button again to turn it off and save battery.'
